Catholic schools in the Diocese of Parramatta are committed to providing an affordable quality Catholic education for families. We understand the financial demands placed on families and seek to keep fees as low as possible. No child who meets the enrolment criteria will be refused enrolment or disadvantaged because of a family's financial circumstances.

Accounts will be sent out at the beginning of the first three (3) terms. The amounts listed below cover costs for a full school year of 41 weeks but are only billed in three (3) terms.

In addition to the above fees each student will be charged a Curriculum/Resource Fee which is the amount that remains at the school and is dispersed to cover the items listed below.

- The purchase, use, upgrade and maintenance of school laptops, ipads, audio visual equipment and other ICT resources.
- Upgrade of software and site licenses
- Subject materials for students.
- All compulsory course excursions and incursions held throughout the year
- Elevate Education (Study Skills)
- Formation Day
- Student ID card,
- Student Diary, College Semester Booklet (published twice per year)
- Photocopying for year group
- Administration charges (general correspondence, certificates, report production, school fee information, examination papers)
- Membership of co-curricula associations ( Chess, Debating, Public Speaking, Maths-on-Line and any other curricula activity that the school may decide to participate in)
- Sports Buses & Venue Costs
- College Swimming and Athletics Carnivals, trophies, ribbons, hire of PA equipment at local level, replacement and acquisition of all sports related equipment used at school, replenishing First Aid materials.
- Diocesan Swimming & Athletics Carnivals, hire of PA equipment at association level.

If your daughter is selected for NSWCCC Schools and NSW All Schools events any associated costs will be at the expense of the parents. Representative sport uniforms are also at the expense of the parents. OR Students participating in a non-compulsory activity may be required to pay any associated costs with the event.
